She was a member of St. Patrick's Catholic Church in Wheatland.

Juarez, both of Casper; a son-in-law and daughter-in-law; two grandchildren; two brothers and four sisters, Arthur F. Juarez, Rita C. Loseke and Bonnie C. Reiss, all of Wheatland, Martha M. Rucker of Laramie, Lucy A. Lietz of Casper and Benny Juarez of Valdosta, Ga.; 19 nieces and nephews; and one great-nephew.

She was preceded in death by her mother Dec. 22, 1997; her father Dec. 29, 1987; two brothers, Carlos Juarez in 1993 and Johnny Juarez in 1967.
