1876-1918

The funeral of Mrs. Samuel Moore was conducted Tuesday afternoon from the residence of Mrs. Katherine Bowie, Rev. Oliver Kingman officiating. The funeral was attended by a large number of people of this city, as Mrs. Moore had lived here a number of years and was well known by many. Mrs. Moore was formerly Miss Edith Anderson, was born in Omaha in 1876, and came to Wyoming and taught school at McGill, Rock Creek and Ft. Laramie, and for a time in Wheatland. In 1899, she was united in marriage to Samuel Moore who preceded her to the better land. Two sons, Alexander and Lee, and one daughter, Nellie D., are left to mourn her departure. Her remains were brought here from Stauton, Va. To which place sons and daughter will return. Funeral was in charge of Harry H. Pepper.
