

# Alice Laycock Morey

June 28, 1914 - December 20, 2003

Funeral liturgy for Alice Laycock Morey, 89, will be held on Saturday, December 27, 2003, at 10:30 A.M. at Saint Patrick Catholic Church in Wheatland, Wyoming, with Father Jan Santich as the Celebrant. Interment will be in the Wheatland Cemetery at Wheatland.

Mrs. Morey died Saturday, December 20, 2003, at Platte County Memorial Nursing Home in Wheatland.

Alice Elizabeth Laycock was born June 28, 1914, in Cheyenne, Wyoming, the daughter of Percy and Catherine (Murray) Laycock. She was raised on the family homestead at Hillsdale, Wyoming. In 1927, they bought the historic Snow Ranch on Bear Creek. Alice graduated from

Chugwater High School in 1931. She married George Morey in 1931 and they divorced in 1940.

In 1942, Alice moved to Cheyenne to work at the U.P. Railroad and, then at Fort Warren Air Force base. In 1944, she began working for the State Livestock and Sanitary Board, moved to the State Game and Fish Department, Wyoming Highway Department and, the Wyoming Insurance Department where she worked for 21 years before retiring in 1976.

She was a member of many fraternal and civic organizations including the following: American Business Women, Employee's Credit Union, Les Secretaries, Laramie County Chapter of M.S., American Cancer Society, Parkinson Association, Laramie

County Chapter of D.O.E.S., Association of Retired Person, Laramie County Republican Women, and was a United Medical Center Volunteer.
