

MOREY, EBEN DAVID

1869-March 12, 1943

Funeral services were held here Monday afternoon for David E. Morey, who died here last Friday, March 12, at the Fairacre hospital in Scottsbluff. Morey had been ill for some time, but was taken to the hospital only a short time before his death.

Mr. Morey, a retired farmer, was born in Pleasanton, Ia. and came to the Chugwater community in 1917, residing there until the time of his death.

Surviving are three sons, Paul of Cheyenne, Robert of Chugwater and George of the U.S. Navy; five daughters, Mrs. Cordelia Flemming of Marsland, Nebr., Mrs. Blanche O'Neil of Bridgeport, Nebr., Mrs. Frances Raleigh of Chugwater, Mrs. Hazel Rhinehart of Wheatland, and Mrs. Muriel Broshar of El Monte, Calif., one sister, one brother, 20 grandchildren and 9 great grandchildren.

The last rites were conducted at the Watson-Dennis chapel by Elders Mabey and Tregeagle of Wheatland and Elders Gunderson and Bartholomew of Scottsbluff. Burial was in Wheatland beside his wife who preceded him in death in December 1941. Pallbearers were Magnus Larson, Clint Cozad, Art Clark, John Kennedy, Tom Miller and Roscoe Bostwick.
