dies suddenly

Many were saddened to learn of the sudden death Sunday, August 4 of Marion (Rugg) Morey at Roundup, Mont. where she had resided for the past 15 years. She had returned home only last week from a family reunion held at the home of her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Art Rugg in Wheatland. Mrs. Morey succumbed to a heart attack.

Mrs. Morey was a native of Wheatland, where she was born March 5, 1915. She attended the Wheatland schools and the University of Wyoming; was a member of the OES and the Christian Science church, and had been employed as deputy county clerk in Roundup for several years.

Last rites were conducted at the Schrader Chapel August 8 at 10:30 a. m. with Mrs. R. F. Kellogg as reader. Interment was in the Wheatland cemetery.
