

MORRISON, BETTY LOU

Betty Lou, the two-year-old daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Milton Morrison, died from cholera infantum in the small hours of Tuesday morning, after an illness of about a week. The family were at LaGrange when she was first taken ill. The case not responding to usual treatment, the little sufferer was brought to Wheatland Saturday, but was beyond help when arriving here.

Funeral services were held in the Congregational church Wednesday afternoon, Rev. R.F. Paxton delivering the sermon. Interment was in the Wheatland cemetery.

The five-year-old daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Morrison was also taken violently ill Monday morning, but being near town was immediately brought to the Wheatland hospital. Her case responded to treatment and she is now believed to be out of danger.
