

MORRISON, LOLA ELIZABETH TADE

September 22, 1877-October 25, 1957

Funeral services were held Monday, October 28, for Lola Elizabeth Morrison, wife of H.J. Morrison at 2:00 p.m. Rev. J.B. Milstead officiated at the services held in the Schrader Chapel.

Mrs. Morrison was born September 22, 1877 in Harrisburg, Iowa and passed away at the Wheatland General Hospital October 25, 1957 following an illness of two weeks. She was the daughter of Wm. A. and Sarah Dewey Tade and had made her home in Wyoming since 1925. She had lived in Wheatland since 1936 and was affiliated with the Baptist Church of Harrisburg, Iowa.

Besides her husband, she leaves to mourn her passing, three daughters, Mrs. Faye Anderson of Chicago, Ill, Mrs. Nellie Shepard, Los Angeles, Calif. and Mrs. Eula Worth of Wheatland; one brother, W.B.
