

MORRISON, MAGGIE MAY THOMPSON

October, 1888-March 29, 1915

Mrs. Maggie May Morrison, wife of Loren Morrison, whose home is near Slater, died on Monday, March 29th. She had been ill since last fall but the seriousness of her condition was not realized and nothing special was done. A week ago she became desperately ill and on Saturday she was brought to the Wheatland hospital but an examination showed her to be in such a condition that the case was pronounced hopeless. Nothing could be done but to relieve her suffering as much as possible until the Great Physician called her to the home beyond. Funeral services were held on Tuesday from the Congregational church, Rev. R.F. Paxton officiating.

Mrs. Morrison was the daughter of Rev. and Mrs. C.B. Thompson who reside 11 miles east of town. She was born in West Virginia in October, 1888, and was married in 1909 to the husband who survives her. When but 15 years of age she dedicated her life to the Divine Master and passed into eternity with calm and smiling assurance, bidding all her loved ones an affectionate "goodbye". The sympathy of all is extended to the bereaved husband and relatives.
