

MOSS, DONALD LAWAYNE
April 2, 1932-September 23, 1966

An extended illness claimed the life of Donald LaWayne Moss, at his home of Sept. 23, 1966. He was born in Wheatland on April 2, 1932, and resided in Crawford, Nebr. and in Denver for a year and a half before moving to Wheatland in 1949. The deceased served with the Army from May 1953 until April 1955 and was a member of the Methodist church.

On June 25, 1955, he was married to Carol Ann Douglas in Mitchell, Nebr. To this union three children were born: Connie Marie and RoxAnne and a son who preceded his father in death on June 2, 1958.

Relatives left to mourn his passing include his wife and daughters; father Howard S. (Ben) Moss and sister, Mrs. R.E. Berg, both of Wheatland; brother, Howard H. (Red) Moss of Riverton and sister, Mrs. Virgil Carnahan of Belle Fourche, So. Dak. His mother, Mary Grace Moss, succumbed on Oct. 30, 1965.

Last rites were conducted by Rev. Henry Hartberg at the Methodist church on Sept. 27 at 2:00 p.m. Military honors were held at the graveside in the Wheatland cemetery. Pallbearers included Lee Beatty, Frank Graves, Odie Warner, Al Pfaff, Homer Curtis and Richard Dinges.
