

MOSS, MARY GRACE COBB  
December 21, 1901-October 30, 1965

An extended illness claimed the life of Mary Grace Moss, well known and respected member of this community, on October 30, 1965, at the Platte County Memorial Hospital. Mrs. Moss was born in College Springs, Ia., Dec. 21, 1901 and lived in Nebraska for several years before moving to the Wheatland vicinity in 1908. She attended the Uva and Wheatland schools and Nebraska Wesleyan College. She worked at the State Bank a number of years before her marriage to Howard S. (Ben) Moss in 1926.

Mrs. Moss was a member of the Methodist church, Women of the Moose, DAR, Friendship club, WTK, WSCS and the Christmas club.
