**Last rites for
Anna Moulding**

Anna May Moulding was born in Dorchester, Nebr. Dec. 18, 1872 to Uriah and Mary Worley. She was married to Thomas Moulding in 1891 at Crete, Nebr. and had resided in Wheatland since 1904. Her husband preceded her in death in 1931. Mrs. Moulding was affiliated with Banner Rebekah Lodge No. 16 and the Methodist church. Death occurred Feb. 8 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital after an extended illness.

Services were conducted by Rev. Clifford Polson, Sr. at the Methodist church Feb. 14 at 10:30 a.m. with interment in the Wheatland cemetery. Rebekah services were held at the graveside.
