Services Held For Benjamin Moulding

Funeral services were held Tuesday, May 3, for Benjamin Clyde Moulding, at the Schrader Prell Chapel, with Rev. Elliott Gaves officiating. Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery. He died Friday, April 29, at the age of 82.

He was born June 8, 1894 in Holyoke, Colo. He came to the Wheatland area as a young boy with his family in 1905. He married Ethel Oliver May 1, 1925 in Wheatland. He and his wife farmed here and operated Ben's Market. In 1951 they moved to Oklahoma and made their home there until his wife's death in 1962 at which time he returned to Wheatland.

He was a member of the Golden Age Club and the Odd Fellows Lodge in Wheatland.

In death he is survived by one daughter, Mrs. Charles Trasker of Ft. Wayne, Indiana, 2 brothers, Lawrence of Wheatland, Thomas Lee of Yuma, Arizona, one sister, Alice Shetler of Fremont, Calif., and one grandchild. He was preceded in death by his wife, Ethel.
