

MOULTON, WILLIAM A.  
June 13, 1859-November 19, 1935

Wm. A. Moulton, a long time resident of this community, passed away in Cheyenne Wednesday night after an illness of short duration.

The body is being brought to Wheatland today and the Longwith Funeral Home will take charge of it.

At this time, funeral arrangements have not been completely but it is thought the services will be held Saturday.

The deceased is survived by his wife and one brother and it is possible that there are other relatives but information concerning the life of the deceased is not available at this time.

Willie A. Moulton, a resident of this community for about 45 years, passed away in Cheyenne last Wednesday after a brief illness.

William Arthur Moulton, son of Parker Card and Sarah Moulton, was born June 13<sup>th</sup>, 1859 at Merrimac, Wisc.

He was married on December 5<sup>th</sup>, 1879 to Sarah A. King. To this union were born Arthur, Grace and Joseph. Grace died in early youth. He is survived by two sons, four step sons and three step daughters, and his widow.

September 22, 1908, he was married to Winnie Hamilton who passed away February 1, 1931.

Mr. Moulton was one of the early settlers of this western country, having come to Wyoming 45 years ago. He spent many years hunting and trapping and for a number of years was a rancher. After retiring he moved to Wheatland where he had made his home until his death.
