

MOYE, ALVIS

January 17, 1881-November 14, 1965

Alvis DeLine Moyer, former resident of Wheatland, succumbed in the Memorial Hospital in Sheridan, Wyoming, November 14, 1965, following an extended illness. Mrs. Moyer was born in Smithland, Iowa on January 17, 1881. She moved to Sheridan in 1915 and resided there until her demise, with the exception of seven years spent in Wheatland from 1950 to 1957. Her first husband, Mr. DeLine, preceded her in death in 1928. She was married to Earl H. Moyer in 1934. Mrs. Moyer was a member of the Methodist Church.

Services will be conducted by Rev. Henry Hartberg at the Schrader Chapel on November 20, 1965 at 1:30 p.m. with burial in the Wheatland cemetery.
