

MOYE, EARL HENRY
February 8, 1888-July 17, 1956

Funeral services were held today (Thursday) for Earl Henry Moye, 68, at 11:00 a.m. at the Schrader chapel. Rev. Thomas Aeschbacher was in charge of the services with military rites at the graveside in the Wheatland cemetery. Mr. Moye, a retired rancher, passed away July 17 at a local hospital after a brief illness.

Mr. Moye was born February 8, 1888 in Las Vegas, N.M. and had been a resident off and on in Wheatland for the past six years.

He was a veteran of World War I and is affiliated with the Catholic church.
