Donald L. Mudd, long time resident of Wheatland, passed away Saturday, March 17, 1979, at the Platte County Memorial Hospital Nursing Wing in Wheatland.

Don Mudd was born Oct. 15, 1896 on a ranch on the Sybille near Wheatland. He was raised on the ranch and attended schools in Wheatland.

He married Nona L. Knerr of Stromsburg, Neb. on May 25, 1921. He and Nona spent most of their years on the ranch on the Sybille. Nona passed away in August of 1976.

In recent years Don has lived in Wheatland and has been caretaker of many yards around town.

He was a member of the United Methodist Church, the Wheatland Odd Fellows Lodge, where he was Past Noble Grand, and a member of the American Legion, having served his country during WW 1.

Don is survived by one niece, Evelyn Evenson, of Lake Oswego, Oregon.

Funeral services were conducted Tues., March 20, 1979, at

the United Methodist Church in Wheatland with the Rev. Virgil Lamm officiating. Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery with the Odd Fellows Lodge conducting the graveside services.
