

MUIR, MARTHA PENNIE
August 12, 1854-March 4, 1904

Mrs. Wm. Muir, whose serious illness had been mentioned in the World, passed away at the family home west of Wheatland, on last Friday morning, Mar. 4th. Funeral services were held at the Congregational church Saturday, at 2:00 o'clock, conducted by Rev. Moore, and were very largely attended by friends and neighbors of the family.

Mrs. Martha Pennie Muir was born in the Shetland Islands, off the coast of Scotland, in 1854, and was 50 years of age. She came to Cheyenne when in young womanhood, and was there united in marriage to the husband who survives her. Three sons also remain to mourn the death of the deceased, Thomas and Wm. Muir, Jr. of Big Timber, Montana and John L. Muir of this place. All members of the family were at the bedside at the time of her death. The family moved from Cheyenne to Wheatland in the spring of 1893, and have since resided here. Mrs. Muir had made many friends in this section. She was a highly esteemed lady, a loving wife and a kind and devoted mother. Her death is greatly regretted and the sympathies of the community goes out to the husband and sons who mourn her loss.
