August 19, 1881-July 15, 1957

Funeral services were conducted at 10 a.m. today, July 18 for Patrick Joseph Mullen, 75 in the St. Patrick's church, Father Dennis officiating. Rosary was held in the Schrader chapel Wednesday at 8:00 p.m.

Mr. Mullen, a retired rancher passed away July 15 following an extended illness at his home.
