

MULLEN, THOMAS LAWRENCE
September 2, 1885-January 16, 1940

Thomas Lawrence Mullen died in the Denver General hospital Tuesday, January 16, 1940. Thus by wire the news was brought to Wheatland which proved to be a keen shock to his old friends and relatives.

Mr. Mullen was born September 2, 1885 in Cheyenne, and with the exception of 15 years in California and Arizona where he had gone in hope of regaining his health, he had spent his entire life in the state. He had made every effort to fight off the dread asthma, but to no avail and as a last resort had gone to Denver January 8 to enter the hospital.

The deceased leaves to mourn his death two sisters, Catherine and Nellie Mullin, of Wheatland, and four brothers, Henry and Patrick of Wheatland, James of Chugwater and Frank of Lander. Mr. Mullen was never married.

Rosary services will be held at the home of the sisters, Catherine and Nellie Mullen at eight o'clock this evening, with funeral services at St. Patrick's church at 10 o'clock Saturday morning.
