

MULLEN, THOMAS LAWRENCE
September 2, 1885-January 16, 1940

Thomas Lawrence Mullen, better known as "Tommy", passed away in the Denver General Hospital Tuesday, January 16. Mr. Mullen who had been in ill health for many years, suffering with asthma, had gone to the Denver hospital January 8 to receive treatment.

He was born September 2, 1885 at Cheyenne and had lived in Wyoming all his life except for fifteen years during which time he made his home in California and Arizona.

Surviving are two sisters, Katherine and Nellie Mullen, both of Wheatland; four brothers, Henry and Patsy of Wheatland, James of Chugwater and Frank of Lander and other relatives and friends.

The body was returned to Wheatland Wednesday where Rosary services will be held at the home of Misses Katherine and Nellie Mullen Friday evening at 8 o'clock and funeral services will be held Saturday morning at 10:30 o'clock from the Catholic church. Interment is to be made in the Wheatland cemetery with Watson and Dennis in charge of arrangements.
