

MULLIN, CHARLES

August 15, 1902-September 27, 1965

Charles Mullin, a lifetime resident of the Wheatland area, succumbed in the DePaul Hospital in Cheyenne on Sept. 27, 1965 following a lengthy illness. Mr. Mullin was born in Wheatland August 15, 1902 and was a member of the Catholic church and the Farm Bureau. His father homesteaded four miles north of Wheatland in 1875.

He is survived by a brother, Ed Mullin of Wheatland, sister, Mrs. Lena McClure of Glendo; nephews Jerry and Larry Mullin of Wheatland and John E. McClure of Washington and a niece, Mary of Denver.

Father Leonard Wren conducted last rites at the St. Patrick's church on Sept. 30, at 10 a.m. Burial was in the Wheatland cemetery. Pallbearers included George Waln, Sonny Criss, John Mylet, Frank Robinson, Jim McGuire and George Mitchell.
