

MULLIN, JERRY THOMAS
February 3, 1928-July 26, 1978

Jerry Thomas Mullin, age 50, passed away at his home northwest of Wheatland Wednesday evening, July 26.

Jerry Mullin was born on his parents ranch, the Mullin Ranch, on February 3, 1928. He attended school in Wheatland and married Harriott Barton in Scottsbluff, Nebraska on July 14, 1947. They returned to his home ranch and ranched there with his parents until his father's death in 1955. Jerry and his wife and three sons have continued to operate the home ranch until the time of his death.

He is survived by his mother, Edna Thomas of St. Joe, Texas; three sons, Tom and John Mullin of Wheatland and Mike Mullin of Cheyenne; one brother, Larry Mullin of Carbondale, Colorado, and two grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his father, Thomas Mulling, one infant brother, Dale, and one infant sister, Cora.

Funeral services were held Friday, July 28, 1978 at the Schrader-Prell Chapel in Wheatland with Dan Barcus officiating.
