

MULLOCK, MATTIE M. FLETCHER
September 18, 1902-September 28, 1924

The death of Mrs. Clarence Mullock, formerly Miss Mattie Fletcher, and a very popular high school pupil and rural school teacher here, came as a surprise and shock to her many friends in this district.

Mrs. Mullock died Monday at her home on a farm near Torrington. She was a graduate of the Wheatland high school class of 1922, following which she taught a year at the Roath school. She was married to Clarence Mullock on May 25, 1923, and is survived by her husband and little son.
