

MUSSELMAN, LYDIA JORDAN
1891-April 3, 1931

Mrs. Lydia Musselman, wife of Jacob Musselman, passed away in Wheatland Friday, April 3rd, at the age of 39 years, 10 months and 5 days. The deceased had taken ill Sunday, March 28th, and her condition became steadily worse until the end.

Funeral services were held from the Methodist church Monday afternoon, Rev. Orman C. King, pastor of that church preached the sermon in English and Rev. Jacob Kisselman, pastor of the Evangelical Bethlehem church, preached the sermon in German. Burial was made in the Wheatland cemetery with the Lyla Watson Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.

Mrs. Musselman was born in Russia and came to this country in 1899, settling at Russell, Kans. In 1908, she was united in marriage to Jacob Musselman and they moved to the Wheatland vicinity in 1913. To this union, five sons, Edward, Gustav, Eitel, George and John, all of Wheatland, and 4 daughters, Mrs. Edna Foulk, Martha, Lydia and Alice, all of Wheatland, were born. She is also survived by her father who lives in South Dakota, and three brothers, one Astor Jordan, who lives east of Wheatland.
