

MYLET, FRANCIS

Funeral services for Francis (Speck) Mylet, 42, a former resident of Wheatland, were held this morning (Wednesday) at 9 o'clock at the St. Patrick's church.

Mr. Mylet passed away at Livingston, Mont. on June 26, after suffering a heart attack. He was a steel worker. The deceased was well known here, having made his home in Wheatland several years ago. His brother, John Mylet, resides on a ranch southwest of Wheatland.

Born in Platte Center, Nebr., "Speck", as he was familiarly known, had lived off and on in this community since 1929. He was a member of the Catholic church.

Rosary services were held at the Schrader Chapel Tuesday evening at 8 o'clock. Fr. Clement Orth officiated at the rosary service and at the church service this morning. Burial was in the Wheatland cemetery.
