

Last Rites For John Mylet Thurs.

Monsignor John Corrigan will conduct funeral services for John Mylet Thursday, December 18, 1975, at 10:30 a.m. at St. Patrick's Church. A rosary will be held Wednesday evening at 7:30 p.m. at St. Patrick's Church. Burial will be at the Wheatland Cemetery.

Jim Graves, Bob Mitchell, Bob Grant, Tony Testolin, Bill Russell, and Fred McGuire will serve as pallbearers.

Mr. Mylet passed away at the age of 69 Monday, December 15, 1975 at his home southwest of Wheatland. A retired rancher, he had lived here since 1925.

Mr. Mylet was born in Clarks, Nebraska December 25, 1905. He was married to the former Kathryn Kuiper. He was of the Catholic faith.

He was very active in the affairs of his community. He served on the Mental Health Board and the American National Cattle Association. He was an honorary member of the Stockgrowers Association and the National Stockgrowers Association. He had served on the Brand and Theft Committee for Wyoming Stockgrowers Association for approximately five years.

Mr. Mylet was a Platte County Commissioner for eight years, a member of District #3 School Board for approximately 12 years and served as director of the Wyoming PCA for eight years. He also belonged to the Platte County Weed and Pest Commission and the Wheatland Knights of Columbus.

In death he is survived by his wife Kathryn of Wheatland; two sons, Tim and Dan both of Wheatland; two sisters, Mrs. Mary Siems and Mrs. Sue Mylet both of Fremont, Nebraska; three grandchildren and two great grandchildren.

One son, Larry, three grandsons, and two brothers preceded him in death.
