

NAGEL, HENRY  
July 22, 1887-August 6, 1952

Wheatland and the South Flats community were deeply saddened Wednesday when they were told of the death of Henry Nagel, a retired farmer, who has made his home here since 1928.

Mr. Nagel was born July 22, 1887, in Russia and died at the age of 65 on August 6 at the Memorial Hospital in Cheyenne, following a two month's illness. He was a member of the Evangelical Reform Church.
