

NASH, CHARLES EDMUND
February 2, 1893-April 17, 1941

Charles E. Nash passed away early last Thursday, April 17, at his home near Slater at the age of forty-nine years. Death followed a lingering illness.

Charles Edmund Nash was born at Newport, Nebr. on February 2, 1893 to Abram Isaac Nash and Charlotte Nash. On September 16, 1912, he was united in marriage to Della Mae Paradise. To this union two children were born, Dwain of Seattle, Wash. and Kathleen Mahrt of Cedar Bluffs, Nebr.

He moved to Wyoming with his family on June 7, 1917 and homesteaded in the Laramie hills. Twelve years later, the family moved to the Slater flats where he lived at the time of his death.

Surviving the deceased are his widow, Mrs. Della Nash, his two children and five grandchildren, Bonnie Dell Nash and Alvin, Joan Delmar and Jerome Mahrt.

Funeral services were conducted from the Watson and Dennis chapel at 2 o'clock Monday afternoon, April 21, with Rev. C.B. Doughty in charge. Interment was made in the Wheatland cemetery
