

NEELY, WALDO WILFRED  
March 28, 1914-May 31, 1940

Waldo Wildred Neely, 26, was born March 28, 1914 at Bolckow, Missouri and died May 31, 1940 from injuries incurred in an automobile accident north of Wheatland.

He has lived in the Wheatland vicinity most of his life, having attended the Wheatland schools and graduating from the Wheatland high school. He has for the past 3 years been a Chevrolet dealer in Torrington.
