Funeral liturgy for Albert Andrew Nelsen, 93, was held Friday, November 26, 1999, at 10 a.m. at Saint Patrick's Catholic Church in Wheatland with Father Jan Santich as Celebrant. Interment was in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mr. Nelsen died Monday, November 22, 1999, at the Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland.

Albert was born July 8, 1906, in Tyler, Minn., the son of Nels and Mina (Bornhoft) Nielsen. He was reared and educated in Lake Benton and married Delia Blanche Zarecky on June 10, 1931 in Elkton, S.D.

Albert worked for Mobile Oil Company from the mid-1930's until his retirement in 1973. During those years he worked in Flandreau, Brookings and Sioux Falls, S.D. He and Delia first retired in Sioux City, Iowa but, moved to Wheatland in 1978.

Albert was a member of Saint Patrick's Catholic Church and the Knights of Columbus. He enjoyed fishing and, having a "neat, leafless" yard.

He is survived by a daughter, Joyce Larscheid and husband, Jon of Wheatland; four sisters, Helen Dahl of Tyler, Minn., Elva Meier of San Luis Obispo, Calif., Edna Kragh of Dawson, Minn., Dagmar Weismann of Tucson, Ariz.; two brothers, Harry Nelson of Slayton, Minn. and Dick Nelson of Tyler, Minn.; five grandchildren; and fourteen great-grandchildren.

Albert was preceded in death by his parents; wife, Delia on July 7, 1992; two sisters; one brother; and a granddaughter, Janet Cochran.
