Mrs. Charles Nelson, 54, died at the Wheatland General hospital Sunday, August 11, following an extended illness. She was born in Lockwood, Mo. in 1862 and had been a resident of this community since 1904. Previous to living in Wheatland, she had resided in Lucerne, Colo.

Mrs. Nelson was a past matron of the O.E.S. and belonged to the Dorcas Society, W.T.K. club and was very active in civic circles. She was affiliated with the Congregational church.
