Luella Pearson Nicholson, 79, died Tuesday, March 10, 1981 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital Nursing Wing, where she had resided the past year.

Luella, the daughter of Charles and Ella Wills Pearson, was born Aug. 4, 1901 in Colorado Springs, Colo. She was baptized and confirmed at the St. John's Episcopal Church in Denver. She was married in Fort Collins, Colo., Dec. 12, 1925 to William Donald Nicholson. They moved to Wheatland in 1944 from Greeley, Colo. Mr. Nicholson was associated with the Great Western Sugar Company. Lou was a dedicated and tireless worker in the community, giving generously of her time and talent to family, church, charity and friends.

She is survived by her daughter, Barbara Lou (Mrs. Charles) Werre of Torrance, Calif., and two grandchildren, Louisa (Mrs. James) Basile and John William Pearson both of California.
