1877-June 26, 1945

Jacob Nickel, Platte county rancher since 1910, passed away at his home west of Wheatland, on Tuesday morning, June 26. Mr. Nickel had been in ill health for some time and died at the age of 68 years. He was born in Wanberg, Russia, and was a member of the Trinity Lutheran church. His wife preceded him in death three years ago.

Funeral services will be held Sunday afternoon at 2 p.m. in the Methodist church with the Schrader funeral home in charge of arrangements.
