

Karl A. Nickel

Funeral services for Karl A. Nickel, 71, will be held today (Wednesday, Nov. 17, 1993) at 10 a.m. at the Trinity Lutheran Church in Wheatland with the Rev. Randall L. Golter officiating. Interment will follow in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mr. Nickel died Saturday, Nov. 13, 1993 in the emergency room at Platte County Memorial Hospital.
