November 3, 1926 - October 12, 2017

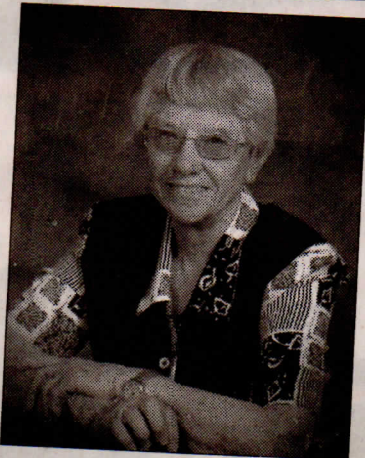
