

NOSS, ARIZONA DILLINGER  
February 23, 1873-March 7, 1929

The Guernsey community was shocked Thursday to learn of the sudden death of Mrs. M.C. Noss. Mrs. Noss had not been in the best of health for several months, and her death was pronounced as being caused by heart failure.

According to the reports of her death, her husband and son Lloyd had breakfast, as usual, their daughter, Vashti, getting the morning meal and they left for their work. The daughter went to call her mother about 9 o'clock and found her dead in bed. Medical assistance was called and it was thought she had been dead for several hours.

Arizona Dillinger Noss, born February 23, 1873, Cape Girardeau County, Missouri, died March 7, 1929, Guernsey, Wyo., aged 56 years and 14 days. Death was due to heart failure.

She was united in marriage February 14, 1894, in Purcell, Indian Territory to Milton C. Noss. To this union were born the following children: Elgin M., Maude L., Vashti M. and Lloyd.

The family came to Wyoming in 1918 from Kansas. They have resided in Guernsey the past 6 years.

The deceased leaves to mourn her sudden departure, her husband and two children, Vashti and Lloyd and one granddaughter, Elaine, and Elgin and Maude having preceded her in death.

Funeral services were held from the Community church Sunday afternoon with Rev. Morton preaching the funeral oration and burial was made in the Wheatland cemetery with the Watson Mortuary in charge of arrangements.
