

NYLANDER, EFFIE MAY SHAPLEY

June 6, 1880-February 6, 1978

Funeral services were held for Effie May Nylander Thursday, February 9, 1978 at the Schrader-Prell Chapel with Pastor Victor Berg officiating. Burial was at the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mrs. Nylander passed away at the age of 97 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital Nursing Wing. She had been a resident in Platte County since 1894.

She was born in Oregon June 6, 1880 and moved by wagon with her family to Colorado. When she was a young girl, they came to Wheatland, again by covered wagon and homesteaded here. After she married Jonas (Mike) Nylander January 1, 1896, at the Bard Ranch, they homesteaded at the foothills of the Laramie Range and ranched there until Jonas passed away in 1949. Mrs. Nylander was a member of the Church of the Nazarene.

Serving as pallbearers were Claude Chambers, Chester Marshall, Julius Galligar, Joe Saverine, Bryce Orr, and Bill Call. Schrader-Prell Funeral Home was in charge of arrangements.

In death she is survived by two sons, August Nylander of Wagner, South Dakota and Daniel Nylander of San Luis Obispo, California; two daughters, Mrs. Bill Peppers of Dwyer and Mrs. Ruth Luck of Springfield, Oregon; four grandchildren, four great grandchildren and one great great grandchild.

She is preceded in death by three daughters, Mrs. Mabel King in 1949, Eva Nylander and infant Charlotte; three brothers and two sisters; and her husband, Jonas.
