

OLIVER, LILIE BELL HAMILTON
December 28, 1881-October 28, 1944

Funeral services were held in the Schrader chapel Sunday at 2 p.m. for Mrs. Lillie Oliver, 62, who died in the home of her daughter, Mrs. Ben Moulding, on October 28, following an extended illness. Rev. Lasher officiated and Robert Barnes, accompanied by Mrs. Robert Kuns, sang.

Mrs. Lillie Bell Oliver was born December 28, 1881 in Kiowa, Kan., and was united in marriage to Samuel E. Oliver in November 1896. He preceded her in death in 1933. She has been a resident of the Wheatland community for the past 18 years.

She is survived by one son, Owen; one daughter, Mrs. Ethyl Moulding; two brothers, Owen A. Hamilton of California and Will Hamilton of Yoder, also a half-brother, Dee Burnson of St. Louis, Mo.; two sisters, Mrs. E.D. Peck of Carmen, Okla., and Mrs. Myrtle Alfred.
