Owen Edgar Oliver, 71, died Tuesday, May 12, at the Platte County Memorial Hospital.

Owen, the son of Samuel and Lillie Hamilton Oliver, was born April 7, 1910 in Carmen, Okla. He moved to Wheatland in 1926 from Oklahoma with his family. They lived on a farm northwest of Wheatland. He worked many years at the Memmer Wrecking Yard, and later worked for Fritz Drube as a machinist. He went overseas to Egypt to work for about six months. He then moved to Saudi Arabia to work as an electrician for Aramco Oil Company in Dhahran.

He was married to Eileen Ruth Clark on June 7, 1964 in Wheatland. He retired in May 1970 and he and Eileen returned to Wheatland.

He is survived by his wife, Eileen, of Wheatland.

He was preceded in death by his parents and one sister, Mrs. Ben (Ethel) Moulding.

Funeral services were held Friday, May 15 at 2 p.m. at the Schrader-Prell Funeral Chapel with the Rev. Virgil Lamm officiating. Interment was in the Wheatland Cemetery.
