

Donald L. Olsen Succumbs At 65

Donald L. Olsen, restaurant manager of Wheatland's Gasoline Alley, died Friday, July 25, 1975 at DePaul Hospital in Cheyenne. He was 65.

Mr. Olsen came to Wheatland from Westminster, Colorado eight years ago. He was born in Valparaso, Nebraska January 4, 1910. He married Phyllis H. Doescher. He was a member of the Trinity Lutheran Church in Wheatland and the Odd Fellows Lodge.
