

OLSON, DAVID H.
March 11, 1893-December 29, 1976

Funeral services for David H. Olson, long time Wheatland area farmer were held Friday, December 31, 1977, at the Schrader-Prell Funeral Home with Rev. Dan Barcus officiating.

Mr. Olson passed away at Veterans Hospital in Cheyenne on December 29, 1976 at the age of 83 after an extended illness.

He served in the U.S. Army during World War I, spending eighteen months on the battlefields of France and Germany. He was honorable discharged on June 2, 1919.

He was a long-time member of the Modern Woodman of America Lodge and the Veterans of Foreign Wars, Laramie Peak Post in Wheatland.

Mr. Olson has been a resident of the Wheatland community since 1938 and has resided in the South Flats area during this time. He was born on March 11, 1893 in Buffalo County, Nebraska and married to Viola M. Pratt on March 24, 1920 in Grand Island, Nebr.

He is survived by his wife, Viola who lives at the family home south of Wheatland; a daughter, Violet Ryff, who lives in Wheatland; a daughter, Doris Moss, whose residence is in Guernsey; and a son, Don, who lives south west of Wheatland. Also surviving are seven grandchildren and six great grandchildren.
