

# Mrs. H. Omstead

## dies at Casper

Mrs. Hattie Belle Omstead of Casper, mother of Gay Robbins of Wheatland, passed away at Natrona Memorial hospital in Casper Feb. 1 following a brief illness.

The deceased was born Aug. 30, 1891 at Ft. Collins, Colo. She was reared in Boulder, and married Ben C. Robbins at Ft. Collins in November 1910. The couple moved to Wheatland in 1918, where Mr. Robbins was engaged in the construction business. He died in 1938. In 1942 she married Harry Omstead at Wheatland, moving to Casper shortly thereafter. Mr. Omstead died in September 1956. Mrs. Omstead was a member of the First Baptist church and the Townsend club.

Following funeral services at Casper the body was brought to Wheatland where graveside services were held Monday at 3 p. m. in the Wheatland cemetery.
