

# Deborah Ellen Osberg

March 9, 1948 - March 29, 2017

Funeral services for Deborah Ellen Osberg, 69, will be held at 10 a.m. Wednesday, Apr. 5, at the Trinity Lutheran Church in Wheatland, with Pastor Lincoln C. Winter officiating. Interment will be in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Deborah Osberg died Wednesday, March 29, at the Wyoming Medical Center in Casper.

Deborah was born Tuesday, March 9, 1948 in Wheatland, the daughter of Karl Alexander and Elsie (Steeley) Nickel. She was raised and educated in Wheatland, and graduated from the Wheatland High School in May, 1966.
