

Kenneth Otto Osberg

November 5, 1913 – August 6, 2004

Kenneth Otto Osberg, 90, of Winner S.D. died Friday Aug. 6, at the Winner Regional Nursing Home.

Funeral services will be at 2 p.m. Thursday at the Winner Regional Nursing Home Chapel, with burial in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Kenneth was born Nov. 5, 1913, at Roslie, Neb., to Otto Swan and Dale (Reed) Osberg. He came to the Wyoming territory in 1916 to homestead with his parents, spending his first years of school in Cheyenne, then moving to attend school at Dwyer where he graduated from the eighth grade.

He was a member of the Masons, where he was initiated as a brother Mason on Oct. 18, 1939.

He graduated from Nelson Auction School on Nov. 6, 1948 at Renville, Minn. and continued his education by graduating from Physical Therapy school in 1950.

Kenneth worked at the Sunrise Mine mining iron

ore for twenty-seven years. After leaving the mine he moved to Guernsey, where he retired from farming after thirty years.

Kenneth married the love of his life, Audrey Dale Hansen of Carter S.D. on Nov. 5, 1942 at Valentine, Neb. With this marriage two children were born a son and a daughter.

He moved to Winner in 1994 to be close to his daughter and family. He spent neatly ten years as a patient at the Winner Regional Nursing Home where the staff became family. They often described him as a very happy go luck person.

He is survived by his son Kenneth Wayne Osberg and wife Debbie of Wheatland; daughter Joanie K. Vogt and husband Don of Winner; two granddaughters, Audra Bettcher and husband Leon of Winner and Sonya Clark and husband Steve of Mitchell, S.D., great-grandchildren,
