Otto Swan Osberg was born on December 21, 1894 at Lyons, Nebr. and passed away Saturday, April 24, 1976 following a heart attack at home, at the age of 81.

He attended Country school near Lyons, Nebr. On October 21, 1912 he married Dale Reed of Dalton, Nebraska. They were blessed with two sons, Kenneth and Keith.
