

PARADISE, MOSES

January 24, 1856-December 6, 1946

Born in Montreal, Canada on January 24, 1856, Moses Paradise died at his home at 10:30 p.m. December 6 following an illness of one month at the age of 90.

The husband of Emma F. Paradise, he came to the United States at the age of 20, making his home in Cedar Bluffs, Nebr. He came to Wheatland a year and a half ago. Mr. Paradise was a retired grocery merchant.

He was affiliated with the Catholic church.

He is survived by three sons, C.J. Paradise, G.B. Paradise, of Wheatland, H.M. Paradise of San Bernadino, Calif., five daughters, Mrs. L.A. Knight of Cedar Bluffs, Nebr., Mrs. Cora Blue and Mrs. Della Nash of Wheatland; Mrs. Elsie Fink of Los Angles, Calif., and Mrs. C.A. Burkman of Omaha, Nebr., one son and one daughter preceded him in death. Also surviving are twenty-four grandchildren and twenty great grandchildren.
