

PARK, HOPSON
August 16, 1871-October 29, 1950

Hopson Park, born August 16, 1871, in Sinclair County, Missouri, died Sunday, October 29 at Garrett, Wyoming, from a sudden heart attack. He was found on the David McFarland ranch, where he had gone for a horse back ride, when found the horse was still standing near by.

Mr. Park was a rancher and had lived in Wyoming for the past thirty years. His wife preceded him in death in 1948.

He is survived by four children, Mimron Park of Leo, Wyoming, Tillman Park of Fairfax, Missouri, Adlai Park of Rock River, Wyoming and Mrs. L.L. Hiatt of Pocatello, Idaho; two sisters, Mrs. Emily Williams of Calway City, California, and Mrs. Carey Pock of Fresno, California; one brother, Overton Park of Clinton, Missouri; seven grandchildren and seven great grandchildren.

Services were held Thursday at 2:00 p.m. in the Schrader Chapel, with Rev. Charles F. Thomas officiating. Burial was made in the Wheatland cemetery.
