

PARK, PHOEBE ANNA MOORE  
August 16, 1877-October 16, 1948

Phoebe Anna Park was born August 16, 1877 in St. Louis, Mo. She was a member of the Baptist Church. For the past 27 years she had lived in Garrett, Wyoming.

She died October 16 after an illness of two weeks at the Platte Community hospital.
