

PARKER, URSA MENEFFEE
November 23, 1889-February 27, 1978

Funeral services were held Wednesday, March 1, 1978 at 2:00 p.m. at the Schrader-Prell Funeral Chapel with the Rev. William Jacoby officiating. Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery. Mrs. Parker passed away at the age of 88 at the Memorial Hospital in Douglas Monday, February 27, 1978.

She was born in Hollenberg, Kansas November 23, 1889. She came to the Wheatland area as a young girl with her family in 1903. They homesteaded in the Chug Flats area and she was educated in local schools. She taught school at the George Parker school in the Fletcher Park area and also homesteaded there. Her neighbor Sam Parker and she were later married in 1911 in Wheatland.

After her marriage, she was postmistress at Wyman. She and her husband raised their family and continued to ranch in the area of their original homestead until his retirement in 1954. They then moved to Wheatland where they made their home until his death in 1962. Mrs. Parker then moved into Platte Manor and in 1975 she was transferred to Michael Manor Nursing Home in Douglas where she has lived until the time of her death.

In death she is survived by two sons, Wilbur of Wheatland and Leslie of Glendo; two daughters, Mrs. Ruby Goodwin of Douglas and Mrs. Doris Shumate of Edina, Missouri; one sister, Lula Shepherd of Wheatland and four grandchildren and five great grandchildren.

Besides her husband, she was preceded in death by one son, Stanley; one brother and several sisters.
