

PARSONS, JACOB PERRY  
March 12, 1867-February 26, 1944

Perry Jacob Parsons was born in Delaware County, Iowa, March 12, 1867, the eldest of eight children, and departed this life at Wheatland, February 26, 1944, being 76 years, 11 months and 26 days of age.

He moved to Nebraska at the age of four years and grew to manhood there. He was united in marriage to Myrtle Chessmore June 6, 1901 at Atwood, Kansas. To this union were born seven children, one of which preceded him in death, dying in infancy.

Mr. and Mrs. Parsons moved to the vicinity of Wheatland in April of 1919 and have since made this their home.

Mr. Parsons or "Pops" as he was familiarly called, was converted when he was 67 years old and united with the Assembly of God church in Wheatland. He was a faithful and consistent christian and an example to all who knew him. We are certain he has passed to his great reward in Heaven.

He leaves to mourn his loss, his wife, three sons, Perry of Guernsey; Kermit of Fort Benning, Georgia; Ulm of Wheatland, and three daughters, Wilma VanOrtwick of Wheatland; Adah Huntzinger of St. Helens, Ore.; Ella Williams of Hanna, Wyo., and 15 grandchildren. Two sisters also survive him, Carrie Taylor of Allegan, Michigan, and Anna Gibson of Hastings, Nebr., besides numerous nieces and nephews, and a host of friends.

Funeral services were held at 2 o'clock Tuesday afternoon at the Assembly of God church, Rev. Omar Johnson of Denver officiating, assisted by Mrs. Lon Miller. Funeral arrangements were under the direction of Schrader's Funeral home.
